Nova Festival site	The music festival is the site of the bloodiest incident in Hamas' October 7th attack on southern Israel.
Shuva Junction	What started with coffee by three brothers now serves 1,000's of soldiers with food and supplies for free.
Army Base	Visit to an army base to hear from the soldiers and have a barbecue together.
